Flemish Brabant has got a whopping three UNESCO World Heritage Sites of its own. Time feels like it's stood still in its two beguinages (head to Leuven or Diest). In centuries past, unmarried women sought them as a tranquil haven from the world's trials and tribulations. And not much has changed, because these beguinages remain oases of peace and calm.

Flemish Brabant's third Unesco site is the enchanted Sonian Forest to the South. Towering birches over 200 years old are scattered throughout. Stretching over 4,000 hectares, the Sonian Forest is one of Belgium's largest forests, and the perfect place for a beautiful walk away from the bustle of Brussels. So, which heritage site will you visit first?

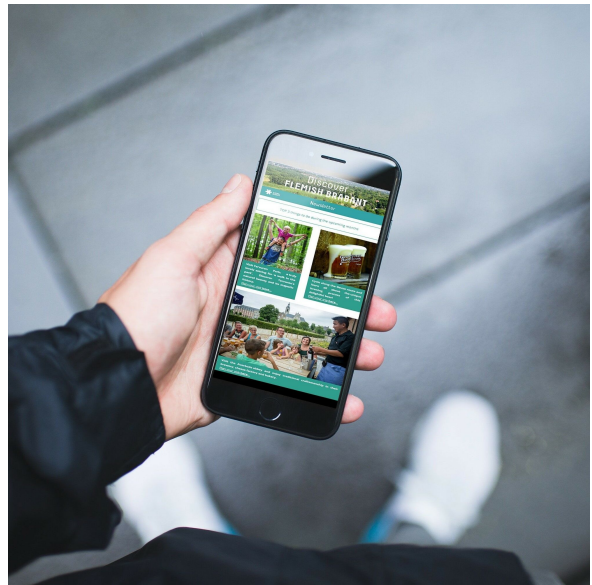
